Norquay – Oliver F. The season was a success for csp despite our low number of patrollers rostered this year. Next year will likely have the same challenge. Norquay needs 5-7 more patrollers to fully meet its commitment to the hill next season. Our year end bbq/election is may 27. At this time it looks as though i will be PL for another season but that may change depending on what happens at the bbq.

Our contact at WinSport recently resigned and his replacement announced. We plan to give the new hire some time to acclimate before we approach. We remain committed to our proposed plan to re-establish a CSP presence at COP on Mon-Thurs evenings during the winter		

season. At this time, the COP patrol is NOT an available option for CSP members/recruits. If/when our proposal is accepted by WinSport, then we will announce our recruitment plan. In summary, the COP Patrol at WinSport continues to be "a work in progress". Stay tuned.	
Lake Louise – Murielle F. - Last day of hill operations was Sunday May 7; reduced terrain due to avalanche concerns - Very successful year for CSP at Lake Louise; the minimum of 8 patrollers was 100% met on weekends (compared to 57% last year), and for ~95% of the weekends, we were at 12. - Increase in benefits in multiple areas from the ski area has demonstrated appreciation for our work - 23 Rookies in total: 5 carry-over from last year, 18 new from the 2016 class. 20 completed orientation - Multiple on-snow training events were held throughout the year focusing on enhancing confidence and competency in new patrollers (code yellow/red scenarios, avalanche rescue, ski improvement, etc). We feel this is critical to retention. - End of year BBQ Celebration is Friday June 2, 2017	
Panorama – Ryan W. Not much to report. Since the last exec meeting I conducted a season wrap up debrief with both the patrol manager and the director of mountain ops. Many good things to report. Overall they are happy with us. They did name the patrollers they want to see back next year as well as those they do not. The advice I am seeking from the board is the proper way to relieve patrollers from a patrol when the hill is not keen with them. In other news we are exploring the option of staffing a cycling event that is occurring mid-June in and around Panorama and Invermere. We will have more information shortly.
