#### New Business

Nor Am Support

Background: The Nor Am downhill event is experiencing a budget shortfall due to loss of sponsorship from the private sector. To replace this funding, event organizers are seeking multiple sponsors to donate small amounts rather than finding one major sponsor. One initiative is to seek funding for breakfasts and the volunteer pizza appreciation night. Sponsors will be recognized as supporters through the event guide that goes to all of the team coaches and with placards at the venue. Recognition of this type will help promote our organization within the ski racing community.

MOTION: To provide financial support to the Nor Am event by sponsoring volunteer appreciation night with a donation of \$1,500, with consideration to continue sponsorship opportunity for subsequent years. Majority carried vote in favor – MOTION PASSED
